We're appealing for witnesses to a serious collision in Kingston St. Mary, Taunton on Thursday 14th January.

The collision, which involved a cyclist and a Range Rover towing a trailer, happened on Kingston Road near the Swan Inn at about 12.40pm.

The cyclist involved was sadly pronounced dead at the scene. His next of kin have been informed and are being supported by specially trained officers.

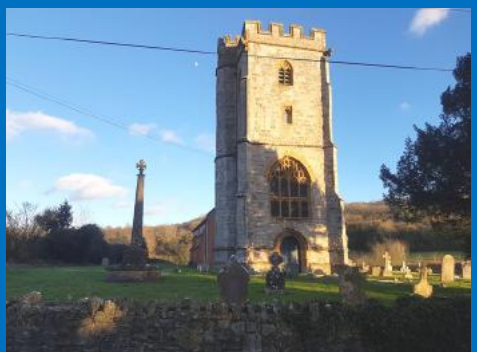
