**(Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2021**  
**(Stoke Stampede 2022 and 2023 Events)**

Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, intends to make an Order, the effect of which will be to introduce the following temporary prohibition of vehicles as detailed in the Schedules below.

The Order will be made to facilitate the 2022 and 2023 Stoke Stampede Event and is in the interest of public safety.

The Order shall come into operation on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of December 2021 and the restrictions will only apply when indicated by traffic signs.

Exemptions are provided in the Order for emergency vehicles.

**SCHEDULE 1**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles**  
**between the hours of 1100 and 1300 on Sunday, 9<sup>th</sup> January 2022**

Dark Lane, Taunton	From the junction with Church Close in a southerly direction to the junctions with Huntham Lane and Church Road
Huntham Lane, Taunton	From the junction with Willey Road in a northerly direction to the junctions with Dark Lane and Church Road
Church Road, Taunton	From the junctions with Dark Lane and Huntham Lane in an easterly direction for a distance of 93 metres

**SCHEDULE 2**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles**  
**between the hours of 1100 and 1300 on Sunday, 8<sup>th</sup> January 2023**

Dark Lane, Taunton	From the junction with Church Close in a southerly direction to the junctions with Huntham Lane and Church Road
Huntham Lane, Taunton	From the junction with Willey Road in a northerly direction to the junctions with Dark Lane and Church Road
Church Road, Taunton	From the junctions with Dark Lane and Huntham Lane in an easterly direction for a distance of 93 metres

**Statement of reasons for making the Order**

- a) because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road;  
or
- b) because of the likelihood of danger to the public, or of serious damage to the road, which is not attributable to such works.
