Our Speaker this year is Xanthe Waite, Community Engagement Officer – Greater Sedgemoor Landscape Recovery Project

The Greater Sedgemoor Landscape Recovery Project is a two year development project, working with multiple landowners, farmers, statutory agencies, communities and other stakeholders across 4,000ha of the Somerset Levels and moors south of the Polden Hills to develop a single, bespoke 20 year land management agreement. The intention of this agreement is to support climate-resilient, nature-friendly farming and land management actions, working to the 'Lawton Principles' of more, bigger, better, and more joined-up.

The Greater Sedgemoor Landscape Recovery Project is a partnership delivered by RSPB and FWAG SW with funding from Defra. It is one of the second round of pilot Landscape Recovery Projects within Defra's new Environmental Land Management (ELM) Scheme.
